## Property Held in Foreign Trade Zone

**Reference Number:** CTAS-1549

Tangible personal property imported from outside of the United States and held in a foreign trade zone or foreign trade subzone, as defined in *Tennessee Code Annotated* Title 7, Chapter 85, for the purpose of sale, manufacture, processing, assembly, grading, cleaning, mixing or display is exempt from Tennessee ad valorem taxation while held in the foreign trade zone or subzone and thereafter, if the property is then exported from the foreign trade zone or subzone directly to a location outside of Tennessee.<sup>1</sup>
